

## Learn Online & Win! Competition Terms and Conditions

This document sets out the terms of participation in the Central Coast Business Enterprise Centre “Ultimate Business IT Pack” competition (the “Competition”).

1. The promoter of this Competition is the Central Coast Business Enterprise Centre (the “Promoter”) (ABN 20 838 813 991), L1/6 Reliance Drive, Tuggerah, New South Wales, Australia.
2. Entry to the Competition is open to all NSW residents. An entrant must hold a current ABN, and be a unique participant to the existing Bringing Small Business Online workshops, professional referral, or previous online learning registrant. Employees of the Promoter and any person associated with the Competition, and any organization or individual associated with the Promoter, are not eligible to enter.

Register for participation by completing all the details required in the Promoter’s online learning portal (<http://www.ccbec.org.au/portal.php>)
